# **THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA**

## **PREAMBLE**

We, the people of India, HAVING SOLEMNLY RESOLVED TO CONSTITUTE India into a SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizen:

JUSTICE , Social, economic and political; LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship; EQUALITY of status and of opportunity; and to promote among them all FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the nation;

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THE CONSTITUTION.

## **THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA**

Chapter IV A

### **Fundamental Duties**

#### **ARTICLE 51 A**

Fundamental Duties : It shall be the duty of every citizen of India:

- a) to abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;
- b) to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our National struggle for freedom;
- c) to uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;
- d) to defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;
- e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women.
- f) to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture.
- g) to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers, wildlife and to have compassion for living creatures;
- h) to develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;
- i) to safeguard public property and to abjure violence;
- j) to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavor and achievement.

## **SCHOOL PARLIAMENT**

In order to foster the spirit of democracy and train the students for a responsible citizenship, a School Parliament is elected every year comprising of School leader, Deputy leaders, School Captain, Fine Arts Secretary and Student editor. Students from classes I to XII exercise their franchise through a Computerised Voting System, the School Parliament provides leadership opportunities to a great extent.

## **SCHOOL FEES**

School fee is to be paid in five instalments. Admission fee and tuition fees once paid will not be refunded. A proportionate increase of fee will be calculated according to the increase in the DA announced by the Central Government.

Fee receipts must be retained and produced as proof of payment, if needed.

## **LIBRARY**

1. Students are expected to utilise the school library to the maximum and keep a record of the books they read in their diary.
2. No one may take any book from the library before having it entered in the Library Register.
3. Damage done to the books or magazines will have to be made good by the borrower.
4. A book may not be kept beyond a fortnight.
5. Students who fail to return the books in time may be fined.

## **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**School timings to be strictly adhered to & participation Morning Assembly is mandatory.**

**1<sup>st</sup> bell 9.15 a.m. Assembly begins at 9.20 a.m.**

1. Students coming to school by own transport must reach in time for the assembly.
2. Students are not allowed to come to school driving vehicles other than bicycles.
3. Students must see that any home work/assignment/projects given to them are submitted in time.
4. School property must be cared for any damage must be reported to the Class Teacher immediately.
5. Money, Articles (such as Binoculars, Cassettes, CDs, Toys, Video games, Mobile Phones, Cameras etc...) should not be brought to school unless specifically asked by the teacher.
6. Wrist watches (not too expensive) are allowed only for students of std. V and above. Students are advised not to remove their watches at school.
7. For birthdays, students can wear coloured dresses. The child may contribute a book to the class library as a lasting and benefitting gift to all his/her classmates.
8. English being the medium of instruction, conversation in the school, except in other language classes should be in English.
9. Students should be responsible for the safe keeping of their belongings. It is suggested that their names be inscribed on articles like lunch boxes, school bags and umbrellas. Students are not allowed to bring valuable items like gold ornaments.
10. Students are responsible to the school authorities, not only for their conduct in school but also for their general behaviour outside.

11. The school uniform is obligatory on all school days. It is the duty of the parents/guardians to see that students come to school neatly dressed in the prescribed uniform.
12. Any students who is not in full uniform should submit a written request signed and recommended by the parent to the Principal or Vice Principal to obtain permission before entering the class room.
13. No student shall be absent from class without sufficient reason. Parents/Guardians must clearly state the reason for the absence in the leave record of the school diary.
14. Those who absent themselves without prior permission shall not enter the class without the Principal's permission. Unauthorised absence for more than 15 days will lead to removal from the rolls.
15. Students suffering from contagious diseases should not be sent to the school.
16. Students are not allowed to go out of the campus during school hours including recess time.
17. No student should bring to school comics, periodicals and other books which do not belong to the school library.
18. Any damage caused to the property of the school or of the other students must be reported to the Principal and will have to be made good.
19. Every student shall endeavour to keep up the high standard of the school by excelling in studies and good manners. Politeness and courtesy must be shown in speech and conduct. Always respect your teachers and elders and greet them suitably.
20. Students will not enter other classrooms without due permission.

21. Verbal requests through messengers or students or themselves to allow them to go home before the school gets over will not be complied with.
22. Perfect discipline should be maintained during tests. Any malpractice will be dealt with seriously.
23. Discourtesy and disrespect to the members of the school staff in any form will be viewed seriously and those responsible for such misbehaviour are liable to be dismissed.
24. The management, Principal and staff will not be held responsible in anyway for mishaps, injuries or loss of life that may occur to the students either on the school campus or while being transported by the school buses.
25. Parents/Guardians are not allowed to enter the class rooms. They can meet teachers only after getting permission from the Principal.
26. Promotion to higher classes and issue of conduct certificates are matters absolutely within the discretion of the Principal.
27. Strict discipline is to be maintained in the class room and no one should remain in the class room during interval.
28. All students should be particularly careful not to throw any papers, seeds, sweet wrappers etc. on the floor or in the compound.
29. Students practicing sports/games after school hours should be in sports dress.
30. **Identity Card** : A well laminated Identity card is issued to every student. Students are required to possess their ID cards in the school and outside the school campus, representing for any activity, competitions in curricular and extra curricular events, sports and games, expeditions and tours.

## **GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS**

1. Ensure that your child is regular & punctual. Incentive prizes are instituted for students with 100% attendance.
2. Text Books and notebooks will be provided by the school. Parents may however be asked to provide materials needed for certain special projects.
3. The school does not encourage children to be taken early or brought late to the school. In case it is unavoidable, the parent must make a note to the class Teacher. While taking a child early from the school, a permission note must be collected from the Class teacher/The Principal.
4. Children should be escorted to and from the school by authorised person only.
5. Ensure that your child comes to school neatly dressed and maintains the dress code prescribed for them.
6. Parents are requested to send wholesome and healthy lunch in unbreakable containers, along with a towel.
7. Parents are requested to inform the school if the child is unwell. In the event of contagious diseases, parents are advised to keep the child at home.
8. Do not meet the teachers during class hours without permission of the Principal.
9. Give all complaints in writing.
10. Excursions are part of education. Encourage your child to avail of this facility as it develops team spirit, co-operation and leadership among the children.
11. The school expects your whole hearted participation in all the school functions and work shops conducted by the school in the interest of your child.
12. The school Counsellor is available at school on all working days, during school hours. In the event of any academic or emotional stress, you may contact the Counsellor through the class teacher.
13. Go through the diary daily; see that it is brought to school everyday. It is an excellent channel of communication.
14. Kindly ensure that your child sets aside timely school work daily. You are requested not to create an atmosphere of stress at home as regards to academic pursuits. However you are most welcome to discuss any point pertaining to the child with the Principal or the respective teacher after consulting the Principal.

## **WITHDRAWAL / REFUNDS FROM SCHOOL / BOARDING**

1. Parents must submit a written request and provide one month notice for any of the above withdrawals.
2. in the case of mid-term withdrawal from school/hostel, the parents are liable to pay the full fee for the remaining terms also.
3. T.C.s will be issued only after settlement of all dues.
4. A transfer Certificate fee of Rs.150/-would be levied for issue of T.C.s.
